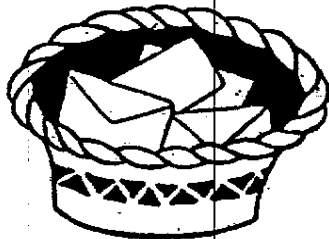

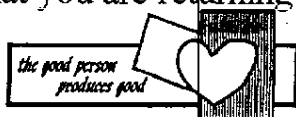
HOLY SPIRIT SOCIETY: The Society will hold their Monthly Meeting at 6:30 in the Parish Center. Prayer Service will follow.
